LeAnn Rimes has been a star for most of her life. She won her first talent contest in her native Mississippi at 5 years old, had her first album finished at 7, recorded her first big hit – “Blue” - on her second album, when she was 11. By 13, she was signed to a national label, and “Blue” hit big!

The rest is history. She has won two Grammy Awards, including the first Best New Artist accolade ever won by a country artist. She has sold more than 37 million records, won an American Music Award, three Academy of Country Music honors and 12 Billboard Awards. She’s scored numerous hit singles, among them “One Way Ticket,” “I Need You,” “Nothin’ ‘Bout Love Makes Sense,” “Probably Wouldn’t Be This Way,” “Can’t Fight The Moonlight” which was a #1 song in 11 countries and “How Do I Live,” which was the longest-running single ever on the Billboard Hot 100, spending a record-setting 69 weeks on the chart.
